

Tuition and Payment Terms:

\$3250 tuition if paid in full by October 1, 2026

\$3500 after October 1, 2026. Payment Plan Is Available

All students booking must pay in full or submit a \$500 deposit to confirm their place in the program.

Payment Plan Option - \$500 Deposit at acceptance. 6 additional payments of \$500 automatically charged on Jan 1, Feb 1, Mar 1, Apr 1, May 1, Jun 1

Tuition includes the program, the manual, and all assigned classes taken on training weekends. Tuition also includes membership to Sol from Dec. 19, 2026- Jun 20, 2027, current memberships will be prorated accordingly. Tuition does not include books.

Missing Training Hours:

Attendance is required for certification. Any missed sessions must be made up in a timely manner. One make up session is included in the cost of the program. If more than one weekend of training is missed, the student must schedule make-up sessions at a rate of \$35 per hour to graduate from the program. Students must contact the program director before the weekend which they will be missing by sending an email to Amy at amy@solpoweryoga.com

Withdrawal Policy:

If a student wishes to withdraw from our program for any reason, they must first contact the program director to discuss their reasons for withdrawal. Refunds will be given in accordance with the program's refund policy.

Termination from Program: Participation/Payment

The program may decide to terminate any student's participation in the program if: (1) false information was used in the admission process that materially affects the program; (2) a student is absent for more than 2 consecutive days without contacting the program director; (3) the student fails to make timely payments of tuition; or (4) the student is unable to pass a test after being given 2 attempts. If the program decides to end the student's participation in the program, the student is not entitled to any prior payments or fees. All prior payments and fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Termination from Program: Conduct

No refunds will be given if the program removes a student from the program for bad conduct. Bad conduct is violation of the Core Values/Program Expectations which includes but is not limited to, gossip, harassment, bullying, or any other behavior that is inappropriate or disruptive to the welfare of the program or to fellow students.

Refund Policy

Upon receiving an acceptance email, the applicant will be contacted to be charged a deposit of \$500. The applicant will have the option to pay in full and receive an early bird discount or enroll in a payment plan. The deadline to pay in full is 10/1/2026

If an applicant withdraws from the program after acceptance, but before the program starts, the applicant's \$500 deposit amount will be retained by the program. However, the deposit can be applied towards a future training program.

The program will not give any refunds or credits after the training starts. The program reserves the right to cancel any training before it begins. In that case any payments applicants have made will be refunded in full.
